The Veil

Heb 9:3 "Behind the second curtain was a second section called the Most Holy Place,"

John 1:3- "All things were made through Him, and without Him, nothing was made that was made."

Hebrews 10:19-20- "Therefore, brothers,^e since we have the confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh."

Col 1:12- "Giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins."

The Ark of the Covenant- Exodus 25:10-17

Inside Ark:

Hebrews 9:4- "having the golden altar of incense and the ark of the covenant covered on all sides with gold, in which was a golden urn holding the manna, and Aaron's staff that budded, and the tablets of the covenant."

Numbers 4:15- "And when Aaron and his sons have finished covering the sanctuary and all the furnishings of the sanctuary, as the camp sets out, after that the sons of Kohath shall come to carry these, but they must not touch the holy things, lest they die. These are the things of the tent of meeting that the sons of Kohath are to carry."

Numbers 16 - Korah's Rebellion

Jude 1:4, 11- "For certain people have crept in unnoticed who long ago were designated for this condemnation, ungodly people, who pervert the grace of our God into sensuality and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ." "Woe to them! For they walked in the way of Cain and abandoned themselves for the sake of gain to Balaam's error and perished in Korah's rebellion."

Mercy Seat- Ex 25:17

"Mercy Seat"-kapōret- covering - Kap- according to/ like. Par-Bullock, Tav-cross "According to the bullock of the sacrifice of the cross.

Lev 16:14. "and dip his right finger in the oil that is in his left hand and sprinkle some oil with his finger seven times before the Lord."

Romans 3:24-26 "being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation (Mercy Seat) by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus."

Hebrews 8:12- "For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more."

Cherubim - Exodus 25:20

Genesis 3:24- "He drove out the man, and at the east of the garden of Eden he placed the cherubim and a flaming sword that turned every way to guard the way to the tree of life."

Zechariah 13:7 "Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, Against the Man who is My Companion," Says the Lord of hosts. "Strike the Shepherd, And the sheep will be scattered; Then I will turn My hand against the little ones"

Jesus-

1 John 3:5 "You know that he appeared in order to take away sins, and in him there is no sin."

1 Peter 2:22 "He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth."

2 Cor 5:21- "For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."

Heb 4:15 "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin."

John 14:30- " I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming. He has no claim on me"

John 10:18- "No one takes it (my life) from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have the authority to lay it down, and I have the authority to take it up again. This charge I have received from my Father."

Revelation 13:8 "All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world."

Hebrews 2:17- "Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people."

1 Timothy 2:5- "For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,"

Romans 1:3-4 "Concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who [a]was born of the seed of David according to the flesh, and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead."

Romans 4:5 "But to him who does not work but believes on Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted for righteousness."

Hebrews 10:2--21- "Therefore, brothers, since we have the confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near

with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.”

Different Temples:

Moses: Mt. Sinai (bondage), thick veil, Aaronic priesthood (system of blessing and cursing), no access to the Holiest, work is never finished, threats of death.

David- Mt. Zion (His rest forever), no veil, Melchizedek Priesthood (just blessing), Free access to holiest, finished work, new and living way.

Psalm 91:1 “He who abides in the secret place of the highest, shall abide in the shadow of the Almighty. He will cover you with his wings. No evil shall befall you.”

Solomon’s Temple- 3 stories, 30 rooms on each floor connected by spiral staircases. Entering in, there were two pillars, 23 cubits each, 46 together- just like your chromosomes/ DNA

Ending:

Col 1:21-22 “And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight.”

Hebrews 10:4 “For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins.”

Colossians 3:1-4 (TPT) “Christ’s resurrection is your resurrection too. This is why we are to yearn for all that is above, for that’s where Christ sits enthroned at the place of all power, honor, and authority! Yes, feast on all the treasures of the heavenly realm and fill your thoughts with heavenly realities, and not with the distractions of the natural realm. Your crucifixion with Christ has severed the tie to this life, and now your true life is hidden away in God in Christ. And as Christ himself is seen for who he really is, who you really are will also be revealed, for you are now one with him in his glory!
